Our challenge to you this year is to visit each of these stories at least 3 times in the week with your children!

Repetition is the key to remembering and understanding a story! You will be amazed that even your youngest children can recount the stories after only a few reads!

As you read together ask comprehension questions such as, "What happened in the story..." and "What was your favorite part" But also help children process why this story is important...what we can learn from it...and what God might be telling us today through the story.

If you have older children as well, consider mixing in readings from the NRSV Bible (Go to Hopebozemanff.com to download a resource for older children and youth and reading the Bible!)
